COURSE

The Graduate Diploma in Leadership is a nested award in the Master of Leadership, designed to equip professionals with a specialised understanding of leadership, integrating leadership theories with spiritual principles and pragmatic application. The award parallels the accepted criteria articulation into professional university awards (such as MBA), specifically providing a pathway to the Master of Leadership program. It can be a destination course or exit point, thus allowing flexibility for students who may wish to start with a shorter postgraduate course before committing to a Master of Leadership or for students who need to exit the Master of Leadership.

The Graduate Diploma in Leadership provides a broad understanding of leadership principles as well as critical, evidence based and innovative thinking skills which are valuable to any professional context. It includes an overview of intercultural communication, as well as governance, law and ethics, as a foundation for good leadership practice. Integrating leadership theory and skills with spiritual principles, this award provides the opportunity for students to explore the implication of their faith in their professional context.

Course Structure

This course structure applies to students enrolled from Semester 1, 2026 onwards.

The course structure is based on two semesters (each of 13 weeks duration), with four subjects taught in each semester. It comprises:

- 40 cp core subjects
- 40 cp electives

To qualify for award of the degree of Graduate Diploma of Leadership a candidate shall accrue an aggregate of at least 80 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects noted below.

Note: Graduate Diploma in Leadership is an early exit pathway for the Master of Leadership

Course Learning Outcomes

- work independently, responsibly and with the level of professionalism expected of an informed practitioner in leadership.
- apply the knowledge and skills developed to develop appropriate evidence-based solutions to new situations;
- work independently, responsibly and with the level of professionalism expected of a practiced professional with an advanced level of expertise in leadership;
- design and implement a major research project in the selected specialisation.



Work Integrated Learning

Work Integrated Learning may be undertaken through various Professional Practice and Professional Experience subjects at AC. These subjects seek to create a direct linkage between the learning, skills and values engaged in lectures, and the reflection which occurs when these are applied in real-life settings. These work-based training subjects comprise of instruction, academic assessment and a placement in a workplace for each subject. To qualify for the award of the Master of Leadership, a candidate is not required to complete any Professional Practice subjects.
